HOLY COMMUNION STATEMENT

As Lutherans we believe and teach the Biblical truth of the Real Presence (not a symbolic representation) of Christ in, with, and under the bread and wine in Holy Communion for the forgiveness of our sins and strengthening of our souls. St. Paul says in 1 Corinthians 11:28-29 that persons should examine themselves before receiving the Lord's Supper so that they do not eat or drink judgment upon themselves.

In addition, when one communes with a group of believers, you are saying that you believe what they teach. Therefore, Lutherans are welcome to commune with us, but others should speak with the Pastor prior to the worship service. Children who have not been confirmed should not receive Communion, but they are encouraged to come forward to receive a blessing. Holy Communion today will be in a continuous fashion at both services.
