Ash Wednesday: On Wednesday, February 21, at 7 PM, we will once again celebrate Ash Wednesday with a service of Imposition of Ashes and celebration of the Lord's Supper. Any person may come forward to receive the sign of the cross of ashes on their foreheads. We ask that if children come forward, that parents first instruct them on the significance of the act, and if the child is too young to grasp the spiritual significance of the act, then they should not come forward. The act of receiving ashes is considered to be a personal decision and if you feel uncomfortable about it, then do not feel compelled to come forward and no one should think any less of you.
