Week 4: How you relate with the world.

Week 5: Your worship life.

The CORE will meet every Sunday in August beginning promptly at 9:00 AM. If you do not yet own a copy of Luther's Small Catechism, you will be given one. Please register for this class by calling the church office during regular hours. Registration is free.
